**4. WORK SESSION**


A. Presentation/Discussion by Superior Tourism And Recreation Team (START).

Julia Guglielmo – START facilitation team - presented the PPT along with other from the Forest Service. The purpose of tonight's session is to learn about START, hear about potential recreation projects in the Superior area and Provide Feedback and additional ideas. Start is a collaborative effort to enhance the opportunity for trails, recreational activities and facilities and visitor amenities in the greater Superior area, including relevant portions for the Globe District of the Tonto National Forest. START envisions a network safe, equitable, and accessible outdoor recreation opportunities. The goal is to get as many user groups as possible. Items discussed were: START activities; START planning area; Current Recreation and Tourism Issues; Project Selection; Focus Areas for Recreation Projects; Montana Mountain Area; Picket Post Area; Airport Area; Three Canyons Area; Wood Canyon Area; Highway 177 Corridor.

They need our feedback, ideas, on our impression of the potential projects described in the PPT. Do we have additional ideas or needs for recreation around Superior?


